The Safe Cross Code

- 1. Always look for a safe place to cross
- 2. Don't hurry! Always STOP and WAIT!
- 3. LOOK all around before you cross the road.
- 4. LISTEN for any traffic.
- 5. If traffic is coming, let it pass. Then look around again.
- 6. When there is no traffic, walk straight across the road.
- 7. Look and listen for traffic while you cross

Walking to School

- Choose a safe route to school, and hold your child's hand at all times
- Teach your child the Safe Cross Code (overleaf)
- Choose a safe place to cross the road— cross with your School Warden if there is one available, or use zebra or pedestrian crossings
- Never allow your child to cross between parked cars. This is extremely dangerous as motorists cannot see your child
- Wear reflective arm-bands and hivis vests

Driving your child to School

If you have to drive your child to school, and walking, cycling or public transport are not an option—REMEMBER:

- Slow Down: Most speed limits have reduced around school zones.
- Take extra care to look out for children walking to school, they can be unpredictable and easily distracted.
- Leave a bit earlier in the mornings to avoid rushing or driving dangerously in order to arrive on time.
- Be extra vigilant when turning left; ensure you check mirrors in case a cyclist coming up the inside of your car.
- <u>Eliminate Distractions</u>: Be conscious and avoid distractions with your mobile phone while driving, a two second distraction could be all the difference

Cycling

- Make sure you / your child is highly visible by wearing reflective clothing
- Always wear protective head gear
- Check the bicycle is a suitable size, and all brakes, lights, reflectors, tyres and bell are all in good working order
- Remember! All cyclists must adhere to Rules of the Road.
- Use dedicated cycle tracks where available, and <u>always</u> stop at red lights
