

School Uniform Policy

The school uniform has been agreed by the Parents' Association and school management. The current policy was reviewed following a survey of parents, children and staff and updated in May 2018.

Only tracksuit or uniform should be worn to school. Alternative tops/hoodies are not acceptable.

The school uniform and tracksuit are available in Happy Events in Mr Price, Blanchardstown Centre, Savvy Schools in CentrePoint Shopping Centre, Leddy Uniform's, Blanchardstown. Second hand uniforms are often available in the St Vincent de Paul Shop, Main St, Blanchardstown. The PA runs a second hand uniform sale at the end of the school year.
