Waste Management

In order to cultivate good habits in our pupils, and to reduce disposal costs, children bring home food waste and leftovers in their lunchboxes. This allows parents to be aware of how much a child is actually eating.

The school provides soap in children's bathrooms but does not supply paper towelling for drying hands. Children are asked to have a face towel in their bags and to take it into the bathroom with them and use it to dry hands. This reduces our waste considerably and also the spread of germs. Many children keep their towel in a small toiletry bag. Parents are requested to check the face towels and change them as required.

We recycle paper and cardboard in the school.
